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What's in this Release

What's new

The 3.0.0.B20593AD907 firmware release adds the following improvements:

- Quad Image (4 active images in a single pane) source added.
- 4 Active images combination.
- Dual stream support for all image sources.
- Flickerless mode for LED lighting environment.

Firmware Upgrade

The Illustra 825 Fisheye Camera can be upgraded via the camera web GUI or by using the Illustra Connect Tool.

Upgrade Camera Firmware via the Web GUI

Note:

All existing camera settings are maintained when the firmware is upgraded.

It is recommended you clear your browser cache after a firmware upgrade.

Procedure: Upgrade Camera Firmware via the Web GUI

1. Use Internet Explorer to connect to the camera with the IP Address and login to the Web GUI.
2. Select **Setup** from the web banner to access the setup menus.
3. Select **Maintenance** from the menu.
4. Select **Camera Upgrade** from the Maintenance menu. The Camera Upgrade tab displays.
5. Select **Browse**. The Choose file dialog is visible.
6. Navigate to where the firmware file has been saved. Select the firmware file then select the **Open** button.
7. Select **Upload**. The file transfer will begin and a progress bar will be displayed.

Upgrade Camera Firmware via Illustra Connect

Note:

All existing camera settings are maintained when the firmware is upgraded.

Procedure: Update Camera Firmware via Illustra Connect

1. Install and launch the Illustra Connect software utility.
2. From the displayed list of cameras; right-click on the camera requiring the software upgrade.
3. Select **Upgrade Firmware**. The Firmware Upload window will display.
4. Select **Choose File** and browse to the firmware upgrade file.
5. Select **Upgrade** to start the upgrade.

Third party software dependency removal

- No dependencies on 3rd Party Utilities for Camera Setup.
- No QuickTime and Java requirements.
- Camera GUI will always use a low resolution MJPEG stream (stream3) for GUI live view.

Enhanced Security

- On initial camera startup, or after a factory default, a user can choose to enable Enhanced Security. This setting can also be changed on the Security Status page on the camera GUI.
- In 2.0 firmware, when Enhanced Security is enabled, HTTP Authentication will be set to Digest. This will require that a user selects Digest authentication when adding the camera to a recorder.
- If Standard Security is selected, HTTP authentication will remain set to Basic.

When in Enhanced security also a number of operations will require authentication when enabling and disabling

Known Limitations and Issues

PRODUCT	
Description	Suggested Work-Around
OSD will not be visible on GUI stream but will apply to main camera stream (RTSP and NVR streaming).	None.
User may experience a discoloration on the Active images – this shall last only a few seconds before the camera adjusts AWB settings.	If the discoloration remains please change and re-select the Image Source, this will correct the issue.
User may experience an Active image showing as a quad image - this lasts only a few seconds before the camera adjusts.	If the incorrect configuration remains please change and re-select the Image Source, this will correct the issue.
Do not remove the SD card when the ExacqVision Application is running. This may cause the camera to reboot.	Stop ExacqVision running first, then unmount the SD card (Edge Recording – SD Card Management) before removing the SD card.
The camera cannot be upgraded with IE8 or IE9.	Use IE10, IE11, Firefox, Chrome browsers or Illustra Connect tool.
Camera upload features (e.g. Certificate uploading, Backup / Restore) do not work on IE 8 or IE 9.	Use IE10, IE11, Firefox, Chrome.
In wall mount options - if factory defaulting and retaining PTZ Preset Pattern and Sequences, camera Mount will be changed from wall to ceiling – this will invalidate the retained Presets Patterns and Sequences making them unusable (112871).	If on wall mount avoid selecting retain Preset pattern and sequences. If already selected and execute Reset again without preserving Preset pattern and sequences.
ONVIF integration: When configuring the i825 Fisheye settings from an ONVIF client any changes made will not be reflected in the i825 Fisheye web GUI (QC2463).	Only the ONVIF client should be used for changing and querying i825 Fisheye settings. The i825 web GUI should not be used in this configuration.
With the camera GUI live view actively streaming and trying to enable meta data (secondary/dual stream) on the NVR will cause the NVR stream to stop. This is due to trying to open a 3rd video stream which the camera does not support. (QC2433).	User should configure the camera on the NVR for stream 1 & 2 before logging into the camera GUI. User should not access/modify live video stream 1 or 2 on the camera GUI while the camera is configured on the NVR.
Backup files are camera specific and therefore should not be installed on different cameras (108561).	None.

Editing date or time will stop any running PTZ features (scan and pattern).	After editing date or time execute PTZ feature again.
User will notice a pink tint to the Ceiling Panorama image when changing between live streams in the GUI – this is an AWB adjustment and will only last a few seconds.	None.
When set to Wall mount - Default Scan limits show -300 and 300 on page when first accessed but these are -30 and 30 – these will show when page is refreshed (110432)	Refresh page to show correct values.
Wall Mode Scan - Left Scan limit can be set to be lower than the Right Scan Limit. This configuration causes the scan to run once and then stop (110431).	Configure scans with left scan limit to be higher than right.
IE cache intermittent issue - changing image mount under motion detection tab does not always update stream in java applet (111274).	Save new stream selection and navigate away from the page and return to page to see correct stream.
IP Filtering table is not cleared with a Factory Default (112870).	Manually clear the table.
After discovery with Illustra Connect, if the list is refreshed the Product name will show extra entry added to the actual name. This is just cosmetic. (104683).	Clear list or restart Illustra connect.
The Pro 5MP FE Fisheye may accept the firmware upgrade from the i625 PTZ, this will only reboot the camera – changes should not be applied to current firmware. (105101).	Only use model specific firmware.
Pro 5MP FE Fisheye FTP may result in 1 second less than buffer set – example pre and post buffer of 5 seconds create a clip of 9 seconds. (105700).	None.

Picture setting - profile restore button will only display during the active session. Once logged out the restore button is no longer available 'Restore' picture settings is not available after a reboot (107343).	None.
Live View buttons are not localized for all languages. (107796)	None.
Privacy zones - When drawing a privacy zone if you touch the border of the image, you lose control of the resize (QC2110)	Do not allow the zone to extend further than the draw area.
ONVIF XML metadata message does not have the <tt:Event> envelope (QC 2552)	None.
Fisheye image will not stream at 1fps and CBR=16 or CBR=10000 (110429)	Stream Fisheye stream at higher FPS.

Technical Tips

Description	Suggested Work-Around
The camera should be configured accordingly prior to being added to a recorder. If factory defaulting the camera it is recommended to remove it from the recorder and reconfigure settings prior to adding back to recorder.	
Logs & Boot log Filter by name will not work if previous result returned 0 values (Lines set to 0). (QC1988).	When using the filter ensure that the lines field has the number of maximum lines that you want to see (figure must be greater than 0).
Date and Time can't be synchronized with an NTP server on an Windows XP machine (QC2081).	N/A.
With the camera GUI live view actively streaming and trying to enable meta data (secondary/dual stream) on the NVR will cause the NVR stream to stop. This is due to trying to open a 3rd video stream which the camera does not support. (QC2433).	User should configure the camera on the NVR for stream 1 & 2 before logging into the camera GUI. User should not access/modify live video stream 1 or 2 on the camera GUI while the camera is configured on the NVR.
With the camera GUI live view actively streaming (or codec sharing) a Stream on NVR, if the user changes the (codec sharing) stream configuration on NVR, this will not update the stream configuration on the camera GUI. This is due to the camera remembering the old rtsp session parameters and therefore the camera live video may fail to stream if you start and stop video. The camera will not automatically be updated with the new stream parameters from NVR. (QC 2434)	User can refresh the camera web page or log out of the camera GUI and log back in again.
In order for the camera to work as expected, It's recommended to remove camera from Milestone before FW upgrade. If the camera was upgraded while on Milestone, see the work around. This is also applicable when changing the image source of a camera in the camera GUI.	User needs to go to Services-> Restart All Services on Milestone. User will also need to Close the application (File->Exit) and re-launch the application.
